Uniform expectations.

At the start of our autumn term, children are expected to wear their summer uniform, up until half term. After this, we transition to winter uniform. Children stay in their winter uniform until the start of the summer term (after Easter). Formal uniforms are to be worn on non-sports days.

All children from Pre – Nursery to Year 3, need to wear their hat or boater whenever they are in their formal uniform. Blazers are to be worn by all children whenever in their formal uniform.

All school items must be clearly labelled, with the child's full name.

Please note the following criteria:

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Sports attire:

Plain white trainers *
White socks
School tracksuit
Black shorts
School polo shirt
Skort for girls (Yr 3 upwards)
Rugby shirt for boys (Yr 1 upwards)

Swimming attire:

School swimming trunks for boys
School swimming costumes for girls
Swimming cap
Swimming goggles *
Towel *

Additional items: (school items, to be worn weather dependant. None school items may not be worn.)

Waterproof mackintosh
Gloves
Scarf
Fleece hat
Sun hat
Art apron (leave at school)

Hair:

Girls:
If hair is longer than shoulder length, it must be tied back neatly, using school bottle green / red hairbands / clips. No large, or excessive headwear please.

Boys:

Traditional barber cut. Neat at all times.

Shoes:

Traditional black school shoes to be worn with formal uniform*

(Velcro fasteners, until able to do laces independently)

White, sturdy sports trainers to be worn with sports uniform

Black plimsolls for boys, to wear at dance and ballet (Early Years – Year 3)

Pink ballet pumps for girls to wear at dance and ballet (Early Years – Year 3)

If children are needing to wear wellington boots due to the weather, they need to be bottle green.*

Jewellery:

No jewellery items are permitted. Girls may only wear simple, round studs if ears are pierced.

Watches are only to be worn by children in Phase 3 and upwards.

Only school issued badges may be worn on clothing.

Toys:

No toys may be bought into school. This includes cuddly toys, key chains on bags, playing cards etc. On occasion, teachers may request certain items to be bought in to enhance learning discussions.

Bags:

Only school bags may be used.

Snack bags are of own choosing. Please label clearly.
